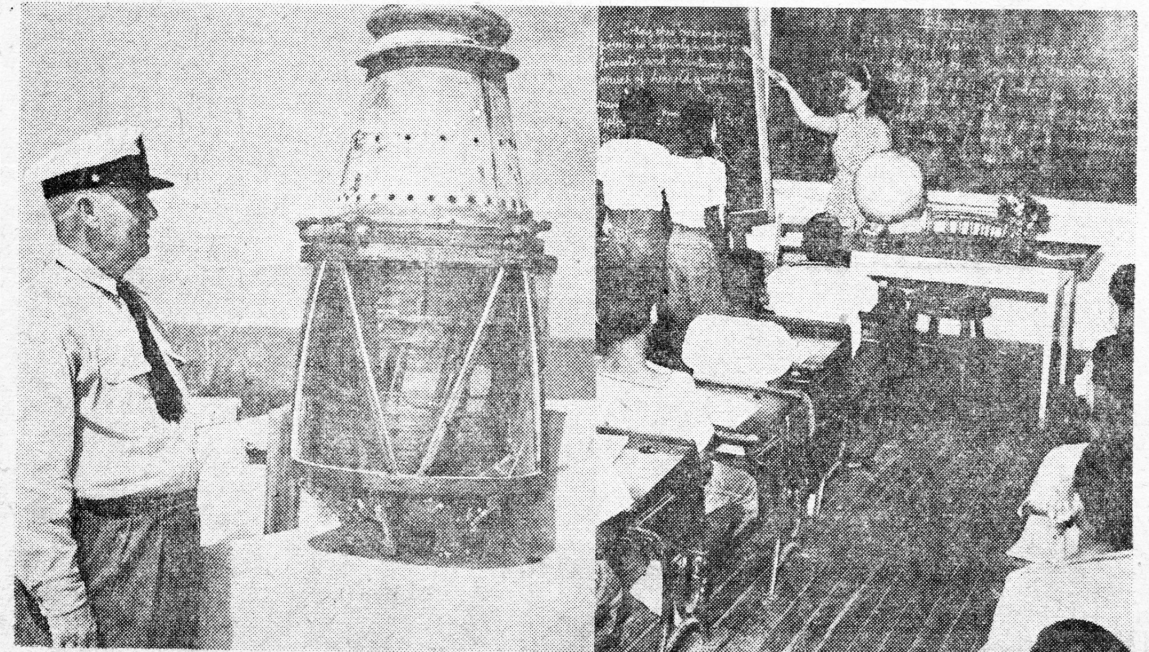
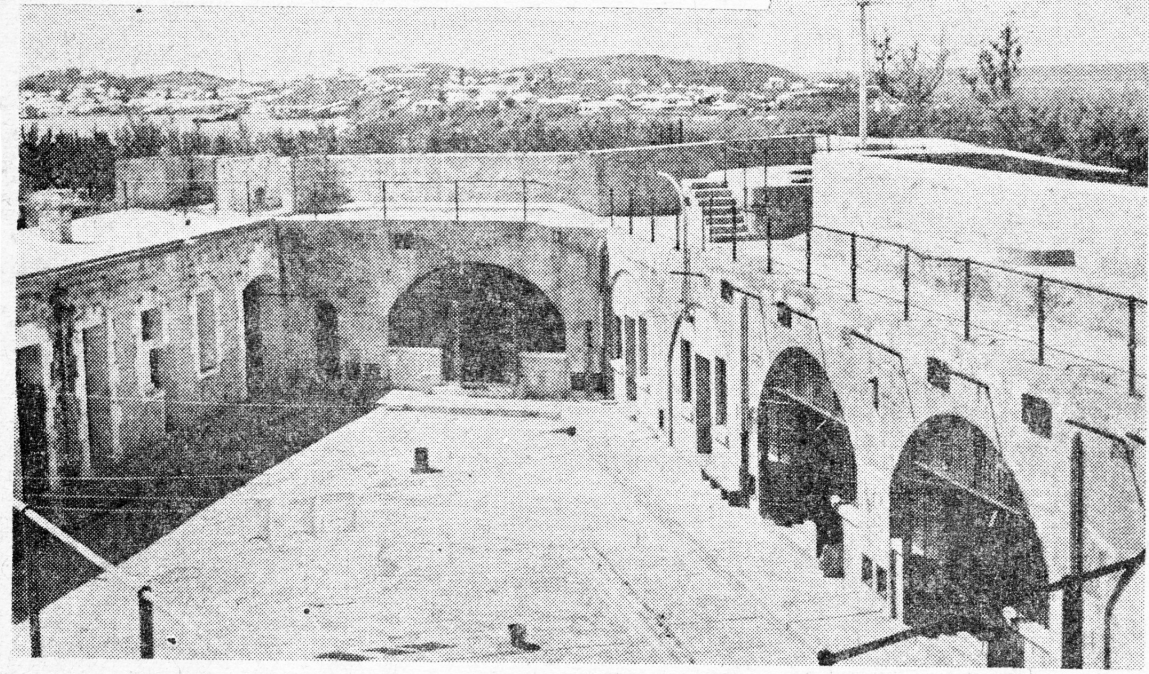


Paget Island lake which provides shelter for small craft. In the centre can be seen the beginning of the channel which connects the lake with the harbour.
