Rules To Be Observed By Visitors

1. Visitors are to be limited to four, of the Boys, Family or Guardians.
2. Intending visitors, **must** apply by telephone, on the Saturday before the second Sunday in the Month. Tel. 9308.
3. PARCELS, one a month; must be of moderate size, and turned over to an Officer on arrival, any food to be consumed during the afternoon can be kept separate. (This rule is designed to safeguard the owner.)
4. MONEY. Must be in a sealed envelope, addressed to the boy, with the amount, and the donors name marked on the outside.
5. Visitors, must keep to the East of a line from the wharf to the North Shore.
6. Litter and refuse of any kind, must be deposited in the place provided for it.
7. You are asked, not to visit if there is any contagious sickness in your family.
8. The top of the Fort is out of bounds, on account of the danger of falling into the Moat.

The above Rules, are designed for the ultimate good of Your Boy, and Your co-operation is earnestly requested for the benefit of all concerned.
